Pre-Anesthesia Consent Form

Bloodwork Consent:

Your pet is about to receive sedation or full anesthesia. Because the anesthesia agents used are cleared through your pet's body by the kidneys and liver, we strongly recommend testing to ensure there is no damage to these organs prior to sedation. Other diseases and conditions, such as diabetes, anemia, and dehydration can also compromise your pet's recovery from sedation. We recommend running some basic bloodwork on your pet prior to sedation to avoid complications. Please initial the statement below that is accurate for your pet.

___ Pet is in good health and under the age of 7 years: Profile #1 includes a Complete Blood Count and 6 Blood Chemistries for **\$56.00**

___ Pet is in good health and over the age of 7 years: Profile #2 includes a Complete Blood Count, 12 Blood Chemistries and an ECG of the heart for **\$89.00**

___ Pets of any age with questionable health status: Profile #3 includes a Complete Blood Count, 12 Blood Chemistries, and ECG of the heart, a T4 (Thyroid level check), and a Urinalysis for **\$102.00**

___ I elect to **decline** the recommended pre-anesthetic bloodwork for my pet and request that you proceed with anesthesia. I understand that there is a potential risk of anesthesia accelerating a condition my pet may unknowingly have and that these conditions may affect my pet's ability to recover fully from anesthesia.

Pain Medication Consent:

We recommend pain medication for all pets undergoing painful procedures such as but not limited to: Ovarianhysterectomy (Spay), Canine Neuters, Dental Extractions, Tumor or Mass Removals, Laceration Repairs, Eye Surgery of any kind, Bladder Stone Removals, Mouth Surgery of any kind.

A 3-day supply of medication can be prepared and sent home with your pet for \$15.00. Please initial the appropriate option for your pet below.
